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WHEREAS, the District has issued and sold certain bonds; and

WHEREAS, the District must levy a tax on all taxable property in the District to provide for payment of interest on and principal of its bonds as said bonds mature; and

WHEREAS, a portion of the tax rolls for the year of 2023 have been finally approved by the Appraisal Review Board; and

WHEREAS, the District has calculated the tax rate necessary to provide for the payment of principal and interest on the District's outstanding bonds as such bonds mature, and further, to provide for the payment of certain operation and maintenance expenses of the District;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF BRAZORIA COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 18 THAT:

### I.

The tax rate for the year 2023 shall be \$0.200 per \$100 of assessed valuation, comprised of \$0.17 per \$100 assessed valuation for debt service purposes and \$0.03 per \$100 assessed valuation for operation/maintenance purposes. The District's Tax Assessor and Collector shall take all steps necessary and authorized by law to collect taxes as owed pursuant to this Order. Said taxes shall be levied, assessed and collected at the rate of \$0.20 per \$100 of assessed valuation for 2023 as provided for in Chapter 49, Texas Water Code, and all other applicable laws.

### II.

The President or Vice President is authorized to do all things necessary for execution of this Order; and the President or Vice President is further authorized to execute, and the Secretary or any Assistant Secretary to attest, this Order on behalf of the Board of Directors.
